NOTICE OF CHANGE OF FUND NAME - EFFECTIVE 28 OCTOBER 2016

NEW NAME: VANECK VECTORS CHINAAMC CSI 300 ETF

Effective 28 October 2016, the word '(Synthetic)' will be removed from the name of the Fund having ASX code 'CETF' resulting in the name of the Fund changing to:

'VanEck Vectors ChinaAMC CSI 300 ETF'

The change reflects the fact that since 19 November 2014 the Fund has not relied on OTC Derivatives above 5% of the net asset value of the Fund and it is Van Eck Associate's intention to continue to manage the Fund without the use of OTC Derivatives.

Capitalised terms in this notice have the same meaning as defined in the Glossary on pages 56 to 58 of the product disclosure statement dated 20 June 2016.
